School Improvement

At this time in the academic year, we assess the progress that we have made towards our School Improvement targets and begin planning our next steps.

This informs the staff CPD and meeting plans, monitoring timetables and subject actions plans.

I will be creating the new school improvement plan with Mrs Hussey over the summer holiday which we will share in September.

We have met as a team to look at long term plans for non-core subjects. At the beginning of every half term, teachers will share via their class Dojo and class website pages. This will include everything you need to know and supporting documents, such as knowledge organisers, for pupils.

Yes Tor News

Pre-school will continue to be based in Yes Tor and share some learning spaces with the Reception pupils who we will refer to as Brentor.

They will follow their own curriculum as they do at present as they are at a different stage in their learning journeys. At times, as they do now, they will join for specific events and enrichments.

Yes Tor pupils will continue to enter and exit via the pre-school side gate.

Brentor News

Brentor will be starting their new chapter as a pure Reception class in September. There are a number of reasons for this decision such as the size of the cohort (we are just over our PAN which is wonderful) and also that the updated Early Years framework lends itself to a pure EYFS class.

We are confident that this will have a positive impact upon our pupils moving forward.

They will be based in the Yes Tor classroom for now but will follow their own planning and curriculum. Mrs Abbott-Bray will share information with you via Class Dojo and the website in September.

Reception pupils will enter through the main school gates and be dismissed from here too. They will join the rest of the school in the hall for lunch and Collective Worship. Once they have settled, they will join the rest of the school for break and lunchtimes and will also be able to attend enrichment clubs (as appropriate). They will be part of main school still but share the Yes Tor space as there are so many fantastic areas, indoors and out, that are perfect for the EYFS curriculum.

PE days for Autumn Term 1 will be Mondays and Wednesdays, please send pupils in PE kit on these days please.

Fox Tor class will consist of Years 1 and 2.

The pupils have had a very successful transition this week and have enjoyed their first few days of Fox Tor. It is also important that children are not late to school. Remember all year groups will start at 9am (gates open from 8.45am so that children are in class and settled ready to learn) and finish at 3.15pm. We closely monitor our attendance and must inform the Education Welfare Officer if individuals fall below 95%. The DfE have published new/updated guidance for schools effective from Sept 22— "Working together to improve school attendance" and "Summary table of responsibilities for school attendance", as this is such a focus area for schools, who are held to account.
