A **compass** is used to help people find their way or to show the position of something. There are four compass points, **North, East, South and West**.



Maps give us information about places. They tell us where places are and help us to identify where things are located. We can use a map to plan a route or journey. A map uses **symbols** to show where these places are. These symbols are explained in a **key**.
