Dear parents/carers,

Welcome back for the second half of Autumn Term. We have had a busy start back which began with a monitoring visit on Monday. As well as our normal learning, Oke Tor visited Launceston College on Wednesday to watch the Royal Shakespeare Company perform "The Merchant of Venice", Brentor have continued to create some fantastic paintings in Art, Fox Tor have been conducting some science experiments about "Forces", Great Links have started learning about Continents and Oceans and Yes Tor have been exploring their new classroom environment. We will soon be starting new themes in each class so please keep an eye out for new Knowledge Organisers (Year 1 up).

<u>Parent meetings</u> - Oke Tor half hour parent meetings have been held today, thank you for your support with these.

Fox Tor (Year 2 only) and Great Links (Year 1 only) will be holding half an hour parent meetings during November, please look out for sign-up sheets (Oke Tor has one up on Dojo). Fox Tor (Year 3 only) and Great Links (Reception) will have the usual shorter parent meetings in November too. There will be longer meetings for these classes in either the Spring or Summer term. **PLEASE NOTE:** Brentor meetings TBC due to recent circumstances.

<u>Home Learning</u> – Please see Dojo for the new Home Learning policy which we will are now officially starting. Reading remains a priority throughout school and we will be holding a parent meeting about this soon. All year groups from 1-6 will be bringing home "Knowledge organisers" to help them learn the knowledge that they will need for their theme learning. If you have any questions, please ask your child's class teacher.

<u>Hamper Donations –</u> We will be putting the Christmas hamper together next week. We would be very grateful for any luxury food/drink items by Wednesday 6th November. Last year was a great success and the hamper was completely filled from donations. Thank you.

<u>Toddler Group</u> – Toddlers next week will bePlease see the website/Facebook page or ask Justine for the activities list for the rest of the term. This is a lovely group of parents and toddlers/babies, which meet on Mondays during term time with the fantastic Justine, with a love of messy play, it is usually a good idea to bring along a change of clothes! Each session is £2.00 and takes place in Yes Tor between 9.00am and 11.00am. Please bring your own snack. We are hoping to run an additional afternoon Toddler session soon, please look out for details.

<u>Breakfast Club –</u> We are currently looking at how we can improve systems for booking and dropping off pupils. In order to ensure that we have the correct staff cover, resources and food, we would like parents to

book breakfast club online through school money. We are looking into this and will let you know when this will be launched. Also, we would be very grateful if parents/carers can drop their child/children via the main entrance where a member of staff will take them through the internal door, again this is to ensure that we are adhering to health and safety and safeguarding procedures. Thank you for your understanding with this.

<u>After-school Clubs –</u> Please can parents/carers collect their children form the main front door at the end of each club. We are exploring options for Tae Kwando as we are aware that this session is much shorter and that it isn't worth going home to come straight back again. We don't expect you to wait outside but need to know who is in the building so we will introduce a signing in system the same as we do for Early Bird Reading. If you do come in for this session, please stay in the hall for safety reasons.

<u>School Money Payments</u> – A reminder that all payments for School Dinners should be made in advance, or paid off in full *as soon as possible*. If you have any issues with payment or access to the website, please see the office and they will help where they can. Please could we ask that there are no outstanding amounts due over half-term. Thank you.

<u>Fire Safety Talks</u> – We have arranged Fire Safety talk for Fox Tor and Brentor on the morning of 14th November. This is an opt service, so you only need to return the slip attached to the letter (sent out in bags, but spare ones in the office if needed) if you DO NOT want your child to take part.

<u>Jumble Sale</u> – The FLS are organising a Jumble Sale for the 30th November at the Lewdown Victory Hall, if you are available to help on this day, please let us know, we really do appreciate all the help we can get at these events and it is this help that ensures these events are a success.
